

Phonics-helping your child at home

The following list of items need to be completed with your child everyday.

1. **Practise reading the red words for your child's level** (see sheet in your child's reading folder) ask your child's teacher if you are unsure.
2. **Revise all known sounds**

3. **Learn a new sound** – (see sheet in your child's reading folder) you can use Mr Thorne does phonics to teach new sounds. Type in 'Mr Thorne does phonics' then the sound you wish your child to learn.
4. **Practise writing the new sound.**
5. **Practise reading green words** (see sheet in your child's reading folder)
6. **Practise writing green words** (see sheet in your child's reading folder)
7. **Practise writing green words in a sentence.**
8. **Read your child's home reading book or a levelled e-book on oxford owl**
